1 – Low

**Generally favourable
avalanche situation**

Travel extremely steep slopes one person
at a time and mind the danger of falling.

Danger level

2 – Moderate

Mostly favorable avalanche situation

Travel very steep slopes one person at a time.
Pay attention to unfavourable snowpack
structure.

Danger level

3 – Considerable

Critical avalanche situation

Use terrain effecently and select best possible route and with minimal exposure. Inexperienced persons are advised to remain on open ski runs and trails.

Danger level

4 – High

Very critical avalanche situation

Stay on moderately steep terrain.
Inexperienced persons should remain
on open ski runs and trails.
